Should We Endorse the Rezoning of Dot Ave?



Since 1992, Dorchester Avenue has been zoned separately from the rest of Dorchester. The BRA is now proposing to roll Dot Ave back into the rest of the neighborhood. The effort is aimed at correcting inconsistencies in zoning districts, regulations, and usage guidelines that may exist between the current Dot Ave and the other Dorchester zoning districts.
